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# A Peek at Our Week

## Reading: Weather

This week we will be reading a variety of nonfiction books about weather. We will be focusing on weather words as well as asking and answering questions about the main idea and key details.

## Writing: Writing Workshop

This week we are continuing to focus on writing and drawing to tell a story. We are still working very hard on adding details (at least 5) and labels to our pictures to help make our stories more exciting. We are still working on stretching out words to write complete sentences and labels.

#### Math: Subtraction

This week we are beginning our Subtraction unit. We will begin by learning to use pictures to subtract.


